

Southeast College Award of Excellence

The Award of Excellence was established with the purpose of empowering students and rewarding those who strive towards a path of academic excellence.

\$1,000 each to 10 Southeast College students enrolled in a full-time post-secondary program at Southeast College.

To be eligible for a Southeast College Award of Excellence, students must:

- Be registered and accepted or conditionally accepted into their chosen full-time post-secondary program by the Southeast College Registrar before June 30th 2021.
- Display a commitment to academic excellence which is reflected by the grades on their registration transcripts.
- Awards will be judged on a combination of academic achievement and early registration (prior to June 30th 2021). Academic achievement will be based on the student submitted enrollment transcripts. There is no additional application necessary.

How to apply for the Southeast College Award of Excellence:

(Deadline: June 30, 2021)

Students who are accepted or conditionally accepted to their chosen full-time post-secondary program delivered through any Southeast College campus prior to June 30th, 2021 will be automatically eligible for the Southeast College Award of Excellence.

How the Southeast College Award of Excellence is awarded:

The Award of Excellence will be distributed to successful recipients at the midpoint of their program provided the recipient is enrolled in and regularly attending classes.

Successful award recipients will receive a letter before their program start date. This letter will serve as a notification to students as to the value of their award, and how the award will be processed. Students who have an outstanding balance on their student account at the time of award payment will have their award credited towards their student account. Students who have a zero balance on their student account at the time of award payment will have the award paid directly to the student. Students who have a third party agency paying their tuition must submit documentation showing tuition will be paid in full prior to award payment if they wish to have the award paid directly to the student.
