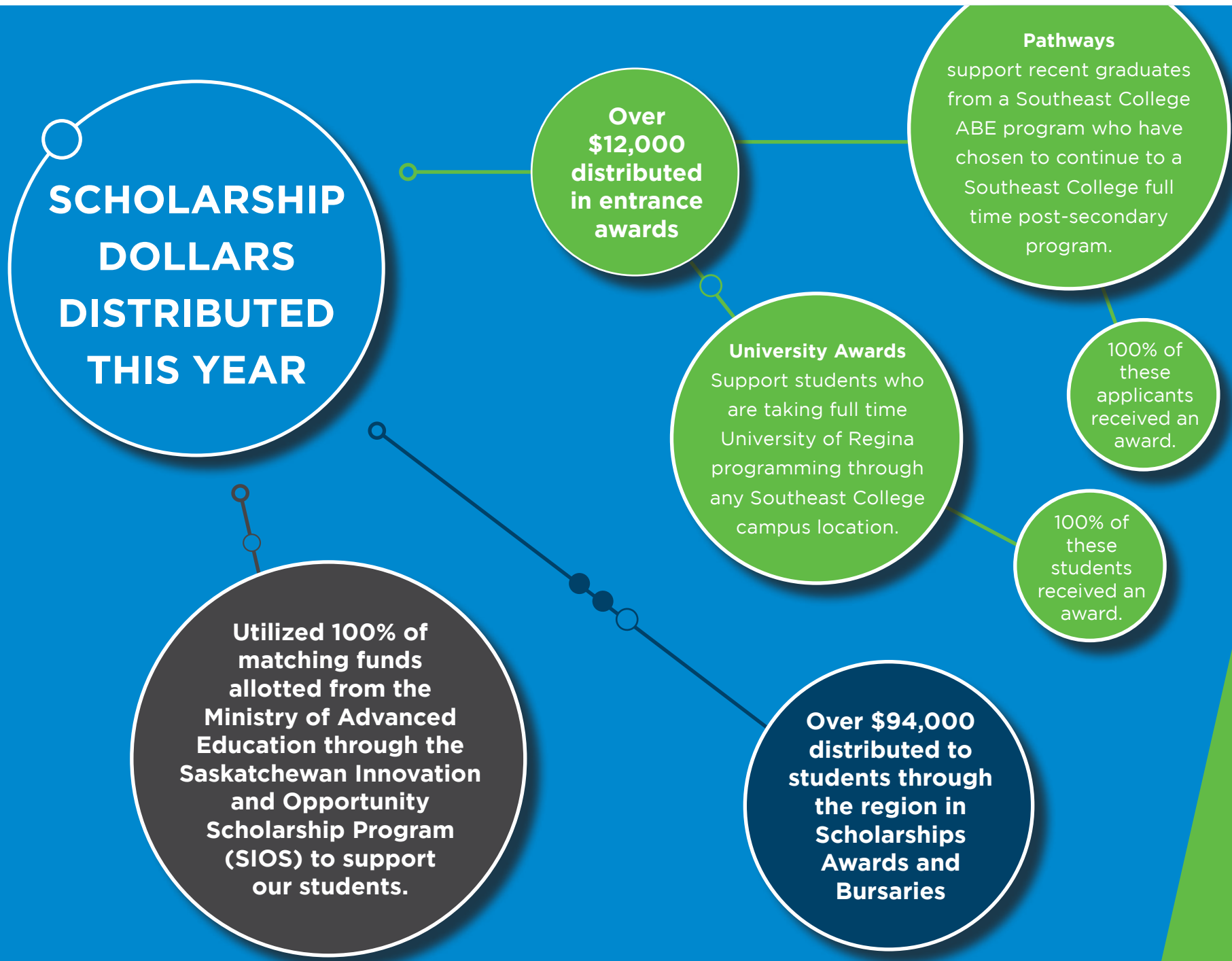

NEW POST SECONDARY DONORS

Health Care Fund: Travelodge Weyburn, Brother Classic Grill: Three Health Care awards were distributed for the first time this year! The Health Care Fund was sparked from a partnership between Travelodge Weyburn, Brothers Classic Grill and Southeast College and is designed to support the education of Southeast College students pursuing careers in Health Care.



This is an increase of:

- 10% more Post-Secondary students applied for awards in 2020/2021 than did in 2019/2020
- 11% more ABE students applied for awards in 2020/2021 than did in 2019/2020

Average dollars taken home by recipients of application based awards:

\$1,700

Critical Needs funds helped students experiencing unexpected hardships due to the COVID19 pandemic meet their basic needs. Funds were available up to the end of September 2020.

Percentage of student body who applied for (Industry Education/Spring Awards) awards

70.5% of Post-Secondary students applied for awards
27.4% of ABE students applied for awards

Critical needs funding continued to be distributed to students needing access to COVID19 emergency funding.
