## Early Childhood Education Student Award

The Early Childhood Education Student Award was established with the purpose of supporting students who choose to pursue a post-secondary education in Early Childhood Education through Southeast College.

**\$1,000 to each student enrolled in the full-time Early Childhood Education Diploma program through Southeast College.**

### To be eligible for the Early Childhood Education Student Award, students must:

- Students must be enrolled in the 2022/23 intake year of the Southeast College Early Childhood Education Diploma program and regularly attending classes.

### How to apply for the Early Childhood Education Student Award:

Students are automatically eligible for the Early Childhood Education Student Award when they are accepted or conditionally accepted by the Southeast College Registrar into the 2022/23 intake year of the Southeast College Early Childhood Education Diploma program.

### How the Early Childhood Education Student Award is awarded:

The Early Childhood Education Student Awards will be distributed to successful recipients at the midpoint of their program provided the recipient is enrolled in and regularly attending classes.

Successful award recipients will receive a letter before their program start date. This letter will serve as a notification to students as to the value of their award, and how the award will be processed. Students who have an outstanding balance on their student account at the time of award payment will have their award credited towards their student account. Students who have a zero balance on their student account at the time of award payment will have the award paid directly to the student. Students who have a third party agency paying their tuition must submit documentation showing tuition will be paid in full prior to award payment if they wish to receive the award paid directly to the student.
