PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Health care cooks are in demand! The Health Care Cook program is designed to prepare cooks for work in various health care settings such as hospitals, long term care and private care facilities. Students will learn to interact with patients and residents, modify diets to meet texture and nutritional requirements and work as part of a team. The combination of hands on cooking skills and theoretical knowledge will reward students with valuable health care cooking experience.

YOUR CAREER

Students that graduate from the Health Care Cook program will have the knowledge and skills for a wide variety of jobs in the health care sector and work full time or part time in personal care homes, long term care homes, hospitals and more.

Estimated annual earning potential ranges from \$23,600 - \$41,600.

ABOUT SASKATCHEWAN

Saskatchewan is located in the prairie region of Canada, bordered by Alberta to the west, Manitoba to the east, Northwest Territories to the north, and the US states of Montana and North Dakota to the south. Saskatchewan is Canada's "sunniest" province, averaging 2,000 to 2,500 hours of sunshine annually. The province has a population of just over 1.1 million, with Regina, the capital city, counting roughly 240,000 and Saskatoon, the largest city, having a population of 300,000.

Saskatchewan is home to 72 of Canada's First Nations, with reserve lands scattered throughout the province. Historically, immigrants were attracted to Saskatchewan by the availability of wide pieces of fertile land. Today it is primarily the province's fast-growing modern economy that attracts new immigrants to build their lives in Saskatchewan.
