



Student Frequently Asked Questions

When do applications open?

Applications are currently open

What are the program dates for 2022?

Start Date: April 11, 2022 (depending on weather)

End Date: June 30, 2022 (depending on the start date)

How do I apply?

Applicants are encouraged to apply online at www.southeastcollege.org

How many pieces of equipment will I be able to operate?

Students have the opportunity to use state of the art simulators for grader, front end loader, dozer, excavator, backhoe and rock truck. New this year the students will have the opportunity to operate all 6 pieces of equipment in the field. The student will receive approximately 240 hours total of field time on all equipment.

What is the tuition cost per program?

Tuition has been set for this program at \$12,500.

Where does the program take place?

Southeast College Estevan Campus

Where does the field work (program project) take place?

Spring/Summer 2022 Project will be located just down the street from our Estevan Campus.

Does the program have education/experience prerequisites?

Grade 10 or Equivalent

Valid Class 5 Drivers License

Minimum 18 years of age at time of application or within 6 months of program completion.

Are there any English Language requirements for your courses?

IELTS 6.5 or DuoLingo 105 will be the requirements for this program

Do you accept foreign transcripts?

Yes, please ensure that students with foreign credentials allow for adequate time for transcript adjudication.

Do you accept international students?

The HEO program is not long enough in length to be applicable to international students.

Is this program eligible for a student loan?

Unfortunately, this program is not student loan eligible. A Southeast College Student Advisor may be able to assist students to find alternative sources of funding.

I have a disability, what supports are available?

You will need to discuss your specific disability with the advisor. We will try to accommodate wherever we can keeping in mind the physical requirements and job suitability that may be required by future employers.

What type of certificate is received upon completion?

Upon successful completion of the program students will receive an industry accredited certificate in Heavy Equipment Operation.

How many students per program?

The student/Instructor ratio for this program is 8:1

Safety Training Certificates for 1st Aid/CPR "A" with AED, Ground Disturbance, Confined Space, WHMIS 2015, SCOT online, TDG online, H2S Alive, Simulated Fire Training.

This training is required to be accepted into the program. If students do not have this training, safety classes will be made available two weeks prior or sooner to program start. This training is at the student's expense.
