Students have access to state-of-the-art simulation equipment in addition to in seat training. Equipment pieces could include backhoe, grader, excavator, loader, rock truck, and dozer. Students should have demonstrated course suitability including but not limited to mathematical ability, excellent vision and a high degree of hand eye coordination. Students should also be in good physical condition as lifting and moderate physical labour are required to work in this sector.



Heavy Equipment Truck & Transport Technician Certificate

This program gives you training in two high-demand mechanical trades at the same time. Heavy Duty equipment technicians work on large mobile equipment: bulldozers, cranes, graders, loaders, & earthmovers used in construction, mining, forestry. Truck & Transport mechanics work on trucks, buses, & highway transport vehicles for dealers, garages & transportation companies.

Graduates of this program may find employment with electrical contractors (both commercial and residential), large manufacturing and mining firms, retail outlets, or wholesale outlets.

University of Saskatchewan Bachelor of Nursing - Pre Professional Year 1

At Southeast College, we offer the opportunity to complete the Bachelor of Nursing pre-professional year at our Weyburn Campus. For the pre-professional year, students will need to apply through the University of Saskatchewan's College of Arts and Science and complete the 30 credit units of courses required for year 1 of the degree program. Students completing the pre-professional year can apply to USask Nursing to continue towards the full nursing degree at a number of sites across the province, including Southeast College Weyburn Campus. The pre-professional year of study at a post-secondary level provides a solid foundation in university education, preparation for upper-year nursing classes and transferable credits to other health science degrees.

High School Prerequisites

To enroll in courses required in the pre-professional year, students must have completed high school with credit in the following courses:

- English A30 and B30
- Biology 30
- Chemistry 30 (recommended) and
- Foundations of Math 30; or
Pre-Calculus 30 or Math B30 or
Math C30 (recommended)



Powerline Technician

Individuals working in this trade construct and maintain overhead and underground power lines and related equipment. They install, maintain, troubleshoot, and repair electrical distribution and transmission systems. Erect and maintain steel, wood or concrete poles, towers, and guy wires. Splice, solder, and insulate conductors and related wiring to connect power distribution and transmission networks using related electrical tools. Inspect and test overhead and underground power lines and cables and associated equipment. Climb ladders or operate hydraulic buckets when working aloft on poles and towers, or work in confined spaces such as trenches and tunnels to install power lines and cables and associated equipment.
