

## Special Project Credit: Career Safety Education

Saskatchewan youth between the ages of 14 -21 can now achieve a high school online credit by completing a Special Project Credit through their school.

[Special Project Credit: Career Safety Education](#) allows youth to enhance their resume with online safety training that aligns to their individual interests and earns them a high school credit while doing so.

Saskatchewan Safety Council has developed an overview document under Saskatchewan Ministry of Education guidelines. The Core modules (Career Safety Education Program) are recommended to be completed within **one school year**.

**Note:** This project must be proposed and approved by student's principal prior to beginning the project. The Special Project Proposal Template located in the overview document provides examples for youth to consider when designing their personal Special Credit program.

To complete a Special Project Credit, 100 hours of work must be imbedded in the proposal. Details are listed in the overview document.
