Awards for Current and Former Adult Basic Education (ABE) Students

Southeast College T.E.A.M. Bursary

T.E.A.M stands for Together Everyone Achieves More, and it's a theme that Southeast College staff have embraced. One \$5,000 TEAM Bursary is awarded annually to a Southeast College Adult Basic Education (ABE) graduate who pursues full-time post-secondary studies at Southeast College.

To be eligible for the T.E.A.M. Bursary, students must:

- Complete ABE Adult 12 on or after January 1, 2020 with a minimum of 5 classes taken at any Southeast College campus
- Enroll into a 2022-23 full-time post-secondary Certificate, Diploma, or University program (first and second semesters) at any Southeast College campus and be “accepted” or “conditionally accepted” by the Southeast College Registrar
- Complete the Southeast College online student awards application and submit a special statement (minimum 500 words) summarizing their desire to pursue a post-secondary education

Jody Holzmilller Scholarship in Memory of Sara Ann Bohanna

The Jody Holzmilller Scholarship was established in memory of a beautiful, brilliant, daughter and mother who believed in the power of education. One \$500 scholarship is awarded annually to an Adult 12 graduate from any 2021-2022 Southeast College Adult Basic Education (ABE) program who is entering a 2022-23 full-time post-secondary Certificate program at Southeast College, or registered in 3 or more 2021-22 first semester university courses at Southeast College

Vermilion Energy – Vermilion Ways of Caring Bursary

Awarded to an adult basic education student transitioning into a full-time post-secondary program through Southeast College.

Recipient should hold strong community leadership values demonstrated through extracurricular activities and/or volunteer involvement. Preference will be given to students living in the southern portion of Saskatchewan and entering the Electrician, Office Administration, or Industrial Mechanics programs.

2 Awards are available, with each award valued at \$3,000.

Definitions

The following is an explanation of some important terminology used in this guide and in the application:

ABE refers to Adult Basic Education programs. A ✓ in the ABE column indicates that students in an ABE program are eligible for those awards.

An **Award** is given in recognition of some specific superior accomplishment.

A **Bursary** is a monetary award given to a student based primarily on financial need. Bursaries also may include consideration of academic achievement, school and community activities, qualities of leadership, or other criteria.

A **Full-time Student** is defined as one who is taking course(s) that collectively require a minimum of 18 hours of scheduled class time per week for a minimum period of 12 weeks. There are two exceptions to this definition:

- a) For Apprenticeship and Trade: a complete level (depending on the trade) is required; and
- b) For university courses: a minimum of 234 hours of scheduled class time for the academic year.

A **Part-time Student** is defined as:

- a) One who is taking courses of less than 12 weeks in duration, even if they collectively require more than 18 hours of scheduled class time per week; or
- b) One who is taking courses that are at least 12 weeks in duration but collectively require less than 18 hours of scheduled class time per week.

Post-Secondary refers to Certificate, Diploma, or University programs. A ✓ in the Post-secondary column indicates that students in a Certificate, Diploma, or University program are eligible for those awards.

A **Scholarship** is a monetary award made primarily on the basis of academic achievement. Scholarships also may include consideration of school and community activities, qualities of leadership, financial need, or other criteria.
